Refractive Surgery Training Programme

The Optical Express refractive training programme, as well as the assessment and certification process, has been designed to develop your knowledge and skills to enable you to confidently manage patients both pre and post operatively.

Stage One OE Academy – Refractive Training Modules

You will receive notification of enrolment to webinars delivered via video conference call by members of our senior clinical team. The webinars will cover the following key topics:



Following completion of the university based training optometrists are required to undertake practical training in the form of clinical placement under the mentorship of our in-house ophthalmologists. Thereafter each optometrist will sit The College of Optometry Therapeutics Common Final Assessment.



Exceptional Technology Exceptional Outcomes

Over £500 million has been invested in our state of the art technology and clinics as part of our commitment to providing each patient with exceptional standards of patient care. As an Optical Express optometrist you will have access to advanced technology including Carl Zeiss and Johnson and Johnson Vision. We continue to invest in and work with industry leading technology to ensure that Optical Express remain at the forefront of leading edge clinical excellence in the ophthalmic industry.



Oculus - Pentacam

The Pentacam is a high-resolution system that provides crisp images of the anterior segment of the eye (i.e. the cornea, iris and crystalline lens). This sophisticated device provides accurate measurements of the curvature and thickness of the cornea, the anterior chamber depth and assesses opacities in the crystalline lens. From the captured images the device is able to calculate a 3D model of the anterior segment of the eye from up to 138,000 image points.



Zeiss - Cirrus 500 OCT

Optical Coherence Tomography (commonly referred to as an OCT scan) is a device which captures detailed images of the retina. As opposed to fundus photography which captures an image of the retinal surface only, the OCT will capture detailed images of the layers of the retina. In addition to the retina, an OCT can also capture detailed images of the cornea.



Zeiss - IOL Master 700 TK Biometer

This piece of technology captures many biometric measurements of the eye and utilises sophisticated formulas to determine the best lens power. The ZEISS IOL Master 700 can capture 2,000 scans per second. Thanks to its outstanding performance, patients can expect improved visual outcomes after their cataract / RLE procedure.

Zeiss - HFA3 Humphrey Visual Field Analyser

This instrument is the gold standard in perimetry, testing visual fields, which can highlight conditions such as glaucoma.



Zeiss - Clarus Wide Angle Fundus Camera

Fundus photography allows us to capture a high resolution image of the retina. A specialist camera is used to capture the central and peripheral retina, the optic disc and the macula. The Zeiss Clarus Wide Angle Fundus Camera is able to capture clear ultra-widefield images so that your Clinician can view parts of the retina that can't be viewed with standard Fundus photography.



Johnson & Johnson Vision - iDesign 2.0

iDesign is a customised treatment option that corrects vision 25 times more accurately than glasses or contact lenses (0.01 dioptre steps). It is an innovative system which produces a detailed 3D map of the eye to enhance the treatment plan for patients who will undertake a laser vision correction procedure. This diagnostic technology allows for an understanding of eye aberrations that can cause quality of vision symptoms, measurement of pupil size and assessment of the shape of the cornea.



Nidek - Specular Microscope

Specular microscopy is a quick and non-invasive test which uses a camera to take high magnification images of the cells in the inner surface of the cornea known as the endothelium. It is otherwise referred to as an endothelial cell count.


